SB 139, SB 160, SB 207, SB 158

### SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 200 authorize participation in contracts by certain board members and employees of water districts. (Introduced)
- HB 1047 revise certain provisions regarding military affairs. (Introduced)
- HB 1048 repeal and make technical changes to provisions regarding the Board of Military Affairs. (Introduced)

### SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 91 revise certain provisions regarding the crime of rape and provide a penalty therefor. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed) (PJPCE)
- SB 142 prohibit certain persons from using the title veterinary technician. (Senate Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)
- SB 144 provide access to abandoned cemeteries to descendants of the decedents interred therein. (Introduced)
- SB 143 (Removed from Consent) raise the revenue threshold for a required audit of a water development district. (Introduced)
- SB 76 (Removed from Consent) provide for licensure by endorsement for certain licensed professionals and occupations. (Introduced)
- SB 171 create term limits for future public utilities commissioners. (Introduced)
- SB 175 modify practice criteria for physician assistants. (Introduced)
- SJR 502 Proposing and submitting to the voters at the next general election amendments to the Constitution of the State of South Dakota revising and establishing certain constitutional provisions regarding the lieutenant governor and the presiding officers of the Senate and House of Representatives. (Introduced)

- HB 1080 prohibit certain medical and surgical interventions on minor patients. (House Health and Human Services Engrossed)
