SB 152, SB 159 (Consent Calendar), SB 168, SB 201, SB 205, SB 156

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 115 revise certain provisions regarding consideration of out-of-state convictions for driving under the influence. (Introduced)
- SB 174 prohibit the enactment or implementation of an ordinance, resolution, or policy that prohibits the use of an energy utility service. (Senate Local Government Engrossed)
- HB 1121 expand the definition of a pesticide dealer. (Introduced)
- HB 1222 limit the liability of permit and certificate-issuing entities and certified use of force instructors. (House Judiciary Engrossed)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 202 clarify the application of use tax and sales tax on the purchase price of certain goods provided to a customer as part of a taxable sale. (Senate Taxation Engrossed)
- SB 185 (Deferred from 25th LD) establish the Committee on Foreign Investment in the United States – South Dakota and revise provisions related to the foreign ownership or control of agricultural land. (Senate Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)
- SB 189 prohibit purchasing agencies from contracting with companies owned or controlled by certain foreign entities or governments. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 191 establish the task force to address the welfare of Indian children in South Dakota. (Introduced)
- SB 206 (Removed from Consent) clarify good cause for the purpose of continuing an involuntary commitment hearing. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 196 provide for the study of long-term care services and to provide an appropriation therefor. (Introduced)

- SB 104 make an appropriation to enhance the economic viability and sustainability of South Dakota and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- SB 105 make an appropriation for improving the social and economic viability of South Dakota and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- SB 111 (Removed from Consent) establish and modify provisions related to economic development. (Introduced)
- SB 112 (Removed from Consent) establish and modify provisions related to taxation. (Introduced)
- SB 113 (Removed from Consent) establish and modify provisions related to education. (Introduced)
- SB 114 (Removed from Consent) establish and modify provisions related to public safety. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1042 (Deferred from 25th LD) update additional charges allowed for mailing decals and plates and to declare an emergency. (House Transportation Engrossed)
- HB 1090 modify protections for agricultural operations from nuisance claims. (House Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)
