HB 1148 clarify registration and residence requirements for voting at a township

HB 1132 revise provisions regarding the duties of the medical marijuana oversight
committee. (Introduced)
HB 1150 provide a medical cannabis patient a registry identification card fee waiver in
certain circumstances. (House Engrossed)

- HB 1210 (Removed from Consent) modify the use of conservation district special
revenue fund monies and to provide an appropriation therefor.
(House Engrossed)
HB 1112 modify provisions for a statewide runoff election. (House Engrossed)
HB 1029 (Deferred from 27th LD) revise certain provisions regarding the county zoning
and appeals process. (Introduced)
HB 1109 (Deferred from 27th LD) modify the occupation tax for business improvement
districts. (Introduced)
HB 1042 (Deferred from 27th LD) update additional charges allowed for mailing decals
and plates and to declare an emergency. (House Transportation Engrossed)
