10 Before any money is expended under this Act, the Capitol Complex Restoration and
11 Beautification Commission shall review each proposed restoration, maintenance, or repair project.
12 If the commission determines that the project will protect and preserve the integrity of a historic
13 area, money appropriated under this section may be expended for the project as prescribed by this
14 Act. "

27 **SB 19:** FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation for the payment of
28 extraordinary litigation expenses and to declare an emergency.

29 **SB 25:** FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation to reimburse health care
30 professionals who have complied with the requirements for health care recruitment assistance
31 programs and to declare an emergency.
