## House Bill 1187

## AMENDMENT 1187A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

1	An Act to make an appropriation for pediatric cancer research and resource projects
2	and to declare an emergency.

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$2,000,000 \$1 to
- 5 <u>the Department of Health, for the purpose of providing grants for pediatric cancer research</u>
- 6 projects and pediatric cancer resource projects in South Dakota.
- 7 **Section 2.** The Department of Health shall establish a temporary advisory committee to
- 8 <u>allocate and award grants for pediatric cancer research and resource projects in South Dakota.</u>
- 9 The advisory committee membership shall consist of seven members appointed by the
- secretary of the Department of Health as follows:
- 11 (1) Two caregivers or survivors of pediatric cancer;
- 12 (2) One representative of a nationwide childhood cancer advocacy non-profit; and
- 13 (3) Four professionals from the childhood cancer field.
- On or before August 1, 2024, the department shall submit a report to the special
- 15 committee, created by § 4-8A-2, detailing the number, amounts, and recipients of the grants
- 16 <u>awarded pursuant to this Act, the resulting research, and other relevant information as</u>
- 17 requested by the special committee.
- 18 **Section 3.** For the purposes of this Act, a pediatric cancer research project means a scientific
- 19 research project focusing on the causes, prevention, education, screening, treatment, or cure
- 20 of pediatric cancer, or the symptoms or effects experienced by patients following completion
- 21 of a course of treatment for pediatric cancer, and may include basic, clinical, and
- 22 <u>epidemiologic research.</u>
- 23 **Section 4.** For the purposes of this Act, a pediatric cancer resource project means a
- 24 <u>community-based educational, informational, awareness, and financial resource project that</u>
- 25 improves the lived cancer experience through an enhanced understanding of the diagnosis,

- 1 <u>treatment, and long-term impacts of childhood cancer, and provides support to reduce its</u>
- 2 <u>emotional</u>, <u>educational</u>, <u>and financial burden</u>.
- 3 **Section 5.** The secretary of the Department of Health shall approve vouchers and the state
- 4 <u>auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.</u>
- 5 **Section 6.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- 6 <u>revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.</u>
- 7 **Section 7.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 8 <u>existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in</u>
- 9 <u>full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.</u>
