CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF COMMITTEES (AMENDED BILLS)

SB 79, HB 1108 (Consent Calendar)

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

HB 1191 clarify the duties of truancy officers. (Introduced)

HB 1189 require certain entities owning agricultural land to report foreign beneficial ownership interests. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

SB 172 make an appropriation for design costs related to the health services center at Black Hills State University–Rapid City, and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)

SB 173 make an appropriation for design costs related to the new Lincoln Hall at Northern State University, and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)

SB 35 make an appropriation to expand laboratory space at the Sanford Underground Research Facility and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)

SB 59 make an appropriation to the Department of Education for grants to support career and technical education infrastructure projects, and to declare an emergency. (Senate Education Engrossed)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1124 modify provisions pertaining to the testing of automatic tabulating equipment. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)

HB 1165 modify certain provisions pertaining to absentee voting. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)

HB 1056 modify the limit of consecutive terms for members of the Board of Technical Education. (Introduced)

HB 1185 prohibit certain restrictions in employment contracts. (House Commerce and Energy Engrossed)

HB 1148 clarify registration and residence requirements for voting at a township meeting. (House Engrossed)
