SCR 602 Affirming the Legislature's support of the United States Supreme Court decision of Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

SJR 505 Proposing and submitting to the electors at the next general election an amendment to the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, updating references to certain officeholders and persons. (Senate Engrossed)

SB 182 establish a uniform method for calculating high school credit received from completing postsecondary courses. (Introduced)

SB 5 extend the termination date of the Juvenile Justice Oversight Council and modify its membership requirements. (Senate Engrossed)

SB 6 authorize community response teams to recommend alternative community-based resources for children alleged to be delinquent and children alleged to be in need of supervision prior to adjudication. (Introduced)

SB 72 revise provisions related to the discharge of a defendant restored to competency. (Introduced)

SB 81 repeal outdated sections regarding enhanced concealed carry permit requirements. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1022 (Deferred from 29th LD) make an appropriation for design costs related to the construction of the new state public health laboratory, and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)

- HB 1016 (Deferred from 29th LD) authorize the South Dakota Department of Corrections to construct a prison facility for offenders committed to the Department of Corrections in Rapid City, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1017 (Deferred from 29th LD) authorize the Department of Corrections to purchase certain real property, to contract for the design of a prison facility for offenders committed to the Department of Corrections, to make an appropriation therefor, to transfer funds to the incarceration construction fund, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1021 (Deferred from 29th LD) make an appropriation to the State Conservation Commission and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1035 make an appropriation to the Department of Revenue for the modernization of the motor vehicle administration system, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1117 make an appropriation to support the small and mid-sized manufacturers, and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1118 make an appropriation to support the South Dakota Small Business Development Center and the South Dakota Procurement Technical Assistance Center, and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1143 make an appropriation for the restoration, maintenance, and repair of the state capitol and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1023 make an appropriation for the construction of a maintenance shop for the Wildland Fire Suppression Division in Rapid City and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1024 make an appropriation for the construction of a maintenance shop for the Wildland Fire Suppression Division in Hot Springs and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1078 make an appropriation to the Department of Human Services for the development and expansion of adult day services programs and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1079 make an appropriation to the Department of Health to provide grants to support mental health and suicide prevention programs, and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 140 (Removed from Consent Calendar) revise certain provisions relating to voter registration. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 86 (Deferred from 29th LD) require candidates for party precinct committeeman or committeewoman to include an email address and phone number in the written statement submitted to the county auditor. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 50 (Deferred from 29th LD) revise the crime of witness tampering. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed) (PJPCE)
- SB 78 (Deferred from 29th LD) create the South Dakota Board of Physical Therapy and make an appropriation therefor. (Introduced)
- SB 198 (Deferred from 29th LD) allow medical cannabis establishments to maintain certain cardholder data and to declare an emergency. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 132 revise the appointment of legislators to the Agricultural Land Assessment Implementation and Oversight Advisory Task Force. (Introduced)
- SB 139 revise residency requirements for the purposes of voter registration. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 146 (Deferred from 29th LD) limit parole for violent offenders. (House Judiciary Engrossed) (PJPCE)

- SJR 502 Proposing and submitting to the voters at the next general election amendments to the Constitution of the State of South Dakota revising and establishing certain constitutional provisions regarding the lieutenant governor and the presiding officers of the Senate and House of Representatives. (Introduced)
- SB 108 provide an educational exception to consumption prohibitions for persons over eighteen years of age who are required to taste an alcoholic beverage as part of a course. (Senate Education Engrossed)
- SB 129 include school employees in certain assault provisions and provide a penalty therefor. (Introduced) (PJPCE)
- SB 176 modify certain requirements for removal from the sex offender registry. (Introduced)
- SB 18 revise the appropriation for a livestock and equestrian complex at the State Fair, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- SB 33 amend an appropriation for the revised construction costs of the Mineral Industries Building at the School of Mines and Technology, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
