- SB 158 make an appropriation to provide funding for major infrastructure projects to support South Dakota airports. (Senate Transportation Engrossed)

- SB 155 create the jail improvement and construction fund for the improvement and construction of jails, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency. (Senate Local Government Engrossed)
- SB 156 make an appropriation of American Rescue Plan Act monies for eligible water projects and to declare an emergency.

- SB 172 (Deferred from 29<sup>th</sup> LD) make an appropriation for design costs related to the health services center at Black Hills State University–Rapid City, and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 173 (Deferred from 29<sup>th</sup> LD) make an appropriation for design costs related to the new Lincoln Hall at Northern State University, and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 35 (Deferred from 29<sup>th</sup> LD) make an appropriation to expand laboratory space at the Sanford Underground Research Facility and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
