- HB 1023 make an appropriation for the construction of a maintenance shop for the Wildland Fire Suppression Division in Rapid City and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1022 make an appropriation for design costs related to the construction of the new state public health laboratory, and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1035 make an appropriation to the Department of Revenue for the modernization of the motor vehicle administration system, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1078 make an appropriation to the Department of Human Services for the development and expansion of adult day services programs and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1024 make an appropriation for the construction of a maintenance shop for the Wildland Fire Suppression Division in Hot Springs and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1079 make an appropriation to the Department of Health to provide grants to support mental health and suicide prevention programs, and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1117 make an appropriation to support the small and mid-sized manufacturers, and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1118 make an appropriation to support the South Dakota Small Business Development Center and the South Dakota Procurement Technical Assistance Center, and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1143 make an appropriation for the restoration, maintenance, and repair of the state capitol and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1055 increase the dollar amount of South Dakota opportunity scholarships. (Introduced)
- HB 1183 (Removed from Consent) authorize the state's participation in the interstate compact on occupational therapy licensure. (House Engrossed)
- HB 1154 (Deferred from 31st LD) modify acceptable conduct for practitioners related to medical cannabis. (Introduced)
- HB 1193 amend provisions of the Uniform Commercial Code. (Introduced)
