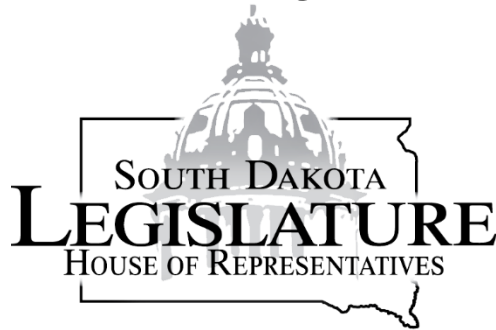

### MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1022 (Consideration of Senate amendments) make an appropriation for design costs related to the construction of the new state public health laboratory, and to declare an emergency. (Senate Engrossed)
- HB 1154 (Consideration of Senate amendments) modify acceptable conduct for practitioners related to medical cannabis. (Senate Engrossed)

- SB 141 clarify and modernize cremation requirements and procedures. (Senate Health and Human Services Engrossed)
- SB 113 establish and modify provisions related to initiated petitions. (House State Affairs Engrossed)

### SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 82 establish the stronger families scholarship program for children in foster care, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency. (House Local Government Engrossed)
- SB 53 (Removed from Consent Calendar) exempt records regarding jail inmate disciplinary matters from public inspection and copying. (Introduced)
- SB 1 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) modify debilitating medical conditions for medical cannabis use. (House Health and Human Services Engrossed)
- SB 118 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) expand eligibility for certain teachers who receive reduced tuition at Board of Regents institutions. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 168 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) authorize a board of a school district to adopt policies regarding students who are registered sex offenders, and to declare an emergency. (Senate Education Engrossed)
- SB 51 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) revise certain provisions regarding the reimbursement of county expenses in detaining parole violators. (Introduced)

- SB 89 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) increase the daily maximum award for the alternative care program administered by the Unified Judicial System. (Introduced)
- SB 104 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) make an appropriation to enhance the economic viability and sustainability of South Dakota and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- SB 197 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) prohibit the spouse of a member of the Legislature from being employed as a private lobbyist. (Introduced)
- SB 207 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) provide a penalty for the expenditure of public funds to influence the outcome of an election. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 70 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) revise provisions related to courtroom modifications for child witnesses. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 91 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) revise certain provisions regarding the crime of rape and provide a penalty therefor. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed) (PJPCE)
- SB 206 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) clarify good cause for the purpose of continuing an involuntary commitment hearing. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 156 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) make an appropriation of American Rescue Plan Act monies for eligible water projects and to declare an emergency. (Senate Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)
- SB 16 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) make an appropriation to rehabilitate the rail line from the city of Milbank to the city of Sisseton and to declare an emergency. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 105 require updated cost report information for certain community-based health and human services providers. (House Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 149 create the Medicaid expansion fund and to transfer monies received as a result of expanding Medicaid eligibility. (House Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 174 prohibit the enactment or implementation of an ordinance, resolution, or policy that prohibits the use of an energy utility service. (House Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- SB 134 revise membership of the Medical Marijuana Oversight Committee. (House Health and Human Services Engrossed)
