SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1137 reduce certain gross receipts tax rates and a use tax rate, and to repeal a conditional reduction of certain gross receipts tax rates. (Senate Appropriations Engrossed) (Fiscal Note)

- HB 1239 prohibit a ban of gas services and appliances used by consumers. (Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- HB 1170 establish mandatory sentences for certain driving while under the influence violations. (House Engrossed) (PJPCE)
- HB 1065 (Deferred from 33rd LD) increase the maximum amount of dollars payable by the state to erect the headstone of a deceased veteran. (Introduced) (Fiscal Note)
- HB 1226 (Deferred from 33rd LD) regulate industrial hemp-derived delta-8 and delta-10 tetrahydrocannabinol products, and other hemp-derived psychoactive compounds, and to declare an emergency. (House State Affairs Engrossed) (Fiscal Note)
- HB 1176 (Deferred from 33rd LD) revise certain provisions regarding on-sale alcoholic beverage licenses for use at municipality-owned facilities. (Senate Local Government Engrossed)
- HB 1167 (Deferred from 33rd LD) annually adjust the rate for community-based providers to one hundred percent of methodology. (Introduced)
- HB 1093 (Deferred from 33rd LD) make an appropriation to enhance the economic health of South Dakota and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1094 (Deferred from 33rd LD) make an appropriation to increase the success of South Dakota and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1142 (Deferred from 33rd LD) improve education outcomes and college affordability. (Introduced)
- HB 1144 (Deferred from 33rd LD) bolster the workforce of South Dakota. (Introduced)
