Senate Bill 156**AMENDMENT 156E
FOR THE HOUSE ENGROSSED BILL**

This bill has been extensively amended (hoghoused) and may no longer be consistent with the original intention of the sponsor.

1 **An Act to ~~make an appropriation of American Rescue Plan Act monies for eligible~~**
2 **~~water projects~~ allocate monies in the state treasury for water and broadband**
3 **projects and to declare an emergency.**

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated \$50,000,000 from the American Rescue Plan Act
6 State Fiscal Recovery Fund, to the Board of Water and Natural Resources, for the purpose of
7 providing grants for eligible water projects in accordance with federal guidance. Monies shall
8 be provided according to the terms and conditions established by the board.

9 **Section 2.** The secretary of the Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources shall
10 approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized
11 by section 1 of this Act.

12 **Section 3.** There is hereby appropriated \$30,000,000 from the American Rescue Plan Act
13 State Fiscal Recovery Fund, to the Governor's Office of Economic Development, for the
14 purpose of providing grants for eligible broadband projects in accordance with federal
15 guidance.

16 **Section 4.** The commissioner of the Governor's Office of Economic Development shall
17 approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized
18 by section 3 of this Act.

19 **Section 5.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
20 revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.

- 1 **Section 6.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 2 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
- 3 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
