An Act to make an appropriation to the Department of Education for grants to support career and technical education programs, and to declare an emergency.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 5 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$5,000,000 to the
- 6 Department of Education, for the purpose of providing grants to school districts or
- 7 multidistricts for equipment for new or existing career and technical education programs.
- 8 **Section 2.** The Department of Education shall consider applications and award grants. To be
- 9 <u>eligible for a grant, a school district must partner, or intend to partner, with another school</u>
- 10 district or multidistrict to offer the applicable career and technical education program. The
- department shall give preference to a school district or multidistrict that:
- 12 (1) Promotes, or intends to promote, postsecondary education and workforce training
  13 education in conjunction with secondary education; or
- 14 (2) Identifies sufficient future local sources of funding for ongoing operating and
  15 maintenance costs associated with the new or existing career and technical
  16 education program.
- The Department of Education may only award a grant to a school district or multidistrict in an amount equal to, or less than, the amount of monies that the school district or multidistrict has secured from local sources on a dollar-for-dollar basis for the career and technical education program.
- 21 **Section 3.** The Department of Education shall accept applications for grants provided by this
- 22 Act no later than June 30, 2024.
- 23 **Section 4.** The secretary of the Department of Education shall approve vouchers and the
- 24 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

- 1 **Section 5.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- 2 <u>revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.</u>
- 3 **Section 6.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 4 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
- 5 <u>full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.</u>
