SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

SB 19 rescind rulemaking authority pertaining to the process for publishing required voter registration numbers. (Introduced)

SB 21 rescind rule-making authority for the annual report of the number of voters removed from a county's voter registration list. (Introduced)

SB 33 repeal the Petroleum Release Compensation Board. (Introduced)

SB 43 establish procedures for the imposition of fines and probation against medical cannabis establishments, and to increase the allowable fee for a medical cannabis establishment registration certificate. (Introduced)
