### SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 59            provide for the downgrade of commercial driver licenses and commercial

certain commercial drivers. (Introduced)
- SB 73            provide that the presiding officer of the Senate is required to sign each

- SB 27            modify the criteria for removal from the sex offender registry.  
(Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 56            permit the operation of a Class I electric bicycle on the Mickelson Trail.  
(Senate Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)
- SB 71            remove a prohibition on the ability of law enforcement and various  
governmental entities to inspect, search, seize, prosecute, or impose  
disciplinary action on cannabis dispensaries, cultivation facilities,  
manufacturing facilities, and testing facilities. (Introduced)
- SB 78            provide for an E15 fuel tax refund. (Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
