SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

SB 11	prohibit a practitioner from referring a patient to a medical cannabis clinic with which the practitioner or an immediate family member has a financial relationship and to provide a penalty therefor. (Senate Health and Human Services Engrossed)
SB 35	provide that certain personal information of a lottery prize winner may only be made public with the winner's consent. (Introduced)
SB 61	repeal the Visitation Grant Advisory Group. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

SB 12	authorize certain employer actions regarding the use of cannabis by an employee or a prospective employee. (Introduced)
SB 20	(Deferred from 7 th LD) establish the crime of threatening or intimidating an election official or election worker and declare an emergency. (Introduced)
SB 27	(Deferred from 7 th LD) modify the criteria for removal from the sex offender registry. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
SB 55	(Deferred from 6 th LD) remove multiple vehicle ownership as a condition for purchasing an additional park entry license at a reduced price. (Introduced)
SB 56	(Deferred from 7 th LD) permit the operation of a Class I electric bicycle on the Mickelson Trail. (Senate Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)

- SB 57 create uniform procedures for consideration of criminal histories and convictions in professional or occupational licensure. (Introduced)
- SB 71 (Deferred from 7th LD) remove a prohibition on the ability of law enforcement and various governmental entities to inspect, search, seize, prosecute, or impose disciplinary action on cannabis dispensaries, cultivation facilities, manufacturing facilities, and testing facilities. (Introduced)
- SB 73 (Removed from Consent Calendar) provide that the presiding officer of the Senate is required to sign each enrolled bill. (Introduced)
- SB 78 (Deferred from 7th LD) provide for an E15 fuel tax refund. (Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- SJR 502 Providing legislative approval for a future use water permit application by the Lewis and Clark Regional Water System. (Introduced)
