

## 2024 South Dakota Legislature House Bill 1117

Introduced by: **Representative** Peterson (Drew)

## 1 An Act to repeal a requirement for the filing of an annual report regarding 2 prearranged funeral trust contracts.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

## 4 Section 1. That § 55-11-9 be REPEALED:

5		Before March first of each year, the owner or manager of each cemetery association
6	or licensed funeral establishment that has entered into any prearranged funeral trust	
7	contra	acts shall file a report covering the period of the preceding calendar year with the
8	State Board of Funeral Service. The report shall include:	
9	(1)	The name and address of the licensed funeral establishment or cemetery
10		association, the name and address of the manager or operator thereof, and the
11		name of the contract holder;
12	<del>(2)</del>	The lump sum consideration paid upon each prearranged funeral trust contract sold
13		or the total amount in dollars of any installments paid upon each prearranged
14		funeral trust contract sold;
15	<del>(3)</del>	The name and address of the banking institution, federal credit union or savings
16		and loan association in which such consideration was deposited;
17	<del>(4)</del>	The total in dollars of all sums received as consideration upon prearranged funeral
18		trust contracts executed by the licensed funeral establishment or cemetery
19		association or in its behalf during all periods after July 1, 1986, which are undrawn
20		or unexpended and on deposit in a banking institution, federal credit union or
21		savings and loan association or in the hands of the licensed funeral establishment
22		or cemetery association; and
23	<del>(5)</del>	The current value, including accrued interest of each prearranged funeral trust

24 contract being held.

- 1 The report shall be accompanied by a filing fee of five dollars. The contracts filed
- 2 under this section are not public records and are confidential records of the board. Failure
- 3 to file this report is a Class 2 misdemeanor.
