### CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF COMMITTEES (AMENDED BILLS)

SB 5 (Consent Calendar), SB 17, SB 18 (Consent Calendar), SB 63, SB 75

### SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 14 expand authorization for the conditional taking of coyotes from snowmobiles. (Senate Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)
- SB 26 clarify the membership of the Open Meeting Commission. (Introduced)
- SB 46 authorize the disclosure of referral status by Department of Human Services personnel. (Introduced)
- SB 76 modify provisions pertaining to the appointment of vacant positions on a board or commission. (Introduced)
- HB 1018 revise certain references to the Internal Revenue Code. (Introduced)
- HB 1019 clarify language regarding sales and use tax in certain statutes. (Introduced)

### SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 43 (Deferred from 6<sup>th</sup> LD) establish procedures for the imposition of fines and probation against medical cannabis establishments, and to increase the allowable fee for a medical cannabis establishment registration certificate. (Introduced)
- SB 57 (Deferred from 8<sup>th</sup> LD) create uniform procedures for consideration of criminal histories and convictions in professional or occupational licensure. (Introduced)
- SB 64 revise provisions related to the regulation of emergency medical services and associated personnel. (Introduced)
- SB 71 (Deferred from 8<sup>th</sup> LD) remove a prohibition on the ability of law enforcement and various governmental entities to inspect, search, seize, prosecute, or impose disciplinary action on cannabis dispensaries, cultivation facilities, manufacturing facilities, and testing facilities. (Introduced)
- SB 73 (Deferred from 8<sup>th</sup> LD) (Removed from Consent Calendar) provide that the presiding officer of the Senate is required to sign each enrolled bill. (Introduced)
- SB 78 (Deferred from 8<sup>th</sup> LD) provide for an E15 fuel tax refund. (Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
