| 3 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: |
| 4 | Section 1. That § 9-3-1.1 be AMENDED: |
| 5 | 9-3-1.1. A municipality may not be incorporated if any part of such the proposed |
| 6 | municipality lies within three miles of any point on the perimeter of the corporate limits of |
| 7 | any incorporated municipality, unless the: |
| 8 | (1) The incorporated municipality refuses or fails to annex a territory which that is |
| 9 | contiguous to <u>said the</u> incorporated municipality, and <u>said the</u> contiguous territory |
| 10 | has properly petitioned-said the municipality to be annexed thereto, as provided |
| 11 | by § 9-4-1. However, a proposed municipality may be incorporated that is within |
| 12 | three miles of an incorporated municipality if the; or |
| 13 | (2) The territory to be incorporated-is has a post office and: |
| 14 | (a) Is in a different county-and has a post office prior to incorporation than the |
| 15 | incorporated municipality; or |
| 16 | (b) The incorporated municipality has a population of less than five thousand. |
