## **House Bill 1129**

Introduced by: Representative Koth

An Act to repeal the session law authorizing the Board of Regents to contract for the design and construction of a new dairy research and extension farm on the campus of South Dakota State University, and to declare an emergency.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4
- 5 **Section 1.** That 2021 Session Laws, chapter 240 be REPEALED:
- 6 Section 1. The Board of Regents may contract for the design and construction of a new dairy 7 research and extension farm on the campus of South Dakota State University in Brookings, 8 together with furnishings and equipment, including heating, air conditioning, plumbing, water, 9 sewer, electric facilities, sidewalks, parking, landscaping, architectural and engineering 10 services, and other services or actions as may be required to accomplish the project.
- 11 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$7,500,000 and 12 the sum of \$7,500,000 in other fund expenditure authority, together with any additional sums received pursuant to section 4 of this Act, for the purposes authorized in section 1 of this Act. 13
- 14 Section 3. The cost estimates contained in this Act have been stated in terms of 2020 values. The Board of Regents may adjust such cost estimates to reflect inflation as measured by the Building Cost Index, reported by the Engineering News Record, and additional expenditures required to comply with regulations adopted after the effective date of this Act. However, any adjustments to construction cost estimates for the project may not exceed one hundred twenty five percent of the estimated project construction cost stated in section 1 of this Act.
- 20 Section 4. The Board of Regents may accept, transfer, and expend any funds obtained for the 21 projects authorized in this Act from federal sources, donations, or any other external sources, 22 all of which comprise a special fund for the benefitted project.

- 1 Section 5. The administration of the design and construction of the project authorized in this
- 2 Act shall be under the general charge and supervision of the Bureau of Administration as
- 3 provided in chapter 5-14.
- 4 Section 6. The executive director of the Board of Regents shall approve vouchers and the
- 5 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
- 6 Section 7. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall revert
- 7 in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.
- 8 Section 8. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 9 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
- 10 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
