HCR 6006 Urging the members of South Dakota's congressional delegation to sponsor and support an amendment to the Payment in Lieu of Taxes (PILT) Act. (Introduced)

- SB 5 reduce the amount of time required before the removal of a city manager is effective. (Senate Local Government Engrossed)
- SB 18 allow the secretary of state to share information from the statewide voter registration file. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 40 establish a criminal background check requirement for licensure as an occupational therapist or occupational therapy assistant. (Introduced)
- HB 1005 revise the manner of citing the Administrative Rules of South Dakota. (Introduced)
- HB 1006 increase the amount of time permitted the Interim Rules Review Committee to review final permanent rulemaking materials. (Introduced)
- HB 1015 adopt the social work licensure compact. (Introduced)
- HB 1026 clarify the requirement for the construction or expansion of a municipal campground or tourist accommodation facility. (House Local Government Engrossed)

- SB 26 (Removed from Consent Calendar) clarify the membership of the Open Meeting Commission. (Introduced)
- SB 57 (Deferred from 9th LD) create uniform procedures for consideration of criminal histories and convictions in professional or occupational licensure. (Introduced)
