CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF COMMITTEES (AMENDED BILLS)

SB 81 (Consent Calendar), SB 86, SB 90, SB 94

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 68 amend certain provisions pertaining to the South Dakota Retirement System to comply with federal law. (Introduced)
- SB 69 amend certain provisions pertaining to the South Dakota Retirement System. (Introduced)
- SB 99 modify provisions pertaining to applying for an absentee ballot application. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1003 update a reference to the Internal Revenue Code for purposes of higher education savings plans. (Introduced)
- HB 1004 update the official code of laws. (Introduced)
- HB 1020 revise the method by which completion of a required suicide awareness and prevention training is verified. (Introduced)
- HB 1074 expand eligibility to practice as a dental hygienist under the collaborative supervision of a dentist. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1024 require that an application for a medical marijuana registry identification card include a notice of federal law regarding firearms and the unlawful use of a controlled substance. (Senate Health and Human Services Engrossed)
- HB 1031 (Deferred from 12th LD) (Removed from Consent Calendar) update the development and implementation of conservation district standards. (Introduced)
- HB 1035 (Deferred from 12th LD) (Removed from Consent Calendar) extend the period of renewal for an enhanced permit to carry a concealed pistol. (Introduced)
- HB 1050 (Removed from Consent Calendar) update references to certain federal motor carrier regulations. (Introduced)
- HB 1055 (Deferred from 12th LD) raise the appraisal value of surplus property that may be sold by a political subdivision without notice. (Introduced)
