3	Section 1. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 34-11:
4	An air ambulance operator may use a ground ambulance to transport a patient
5	between:
6	(1) An acute care hospital and the airport at which the service maintains its ordinary
7	and usual place of business; and
8	(2) The airport at which the air ambulance operator maintains its ordinary and usual
9	place of business and an acute care hospital.
10	Section 2. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 34-11:

12	An A hospital-based air ambulance operator may utilize the operator's ground
13	ambulance for the transfer of a patient from one healthcare facility to another healthcare
14	facility if:
15	(1) The patient's attending medical practitioner determines that the patient requires a
16	level of care that is not available without a transfer; and
17	(2) The operator is unable to use the operator's air ambulance to transport the patient
18	due to:
19	(1) The hospital-based air ambulance operator holds a 14 C.F.R. Part 135 (January 1,
20	2024) certificate;
21	(2) The area's primary ambulance service provider is first given the opportunity to
22	transport the patient but is unable to:
23	(a) Provide the transport because of insufficient staffing;
24	(b) Provide the transport because doing so is outside of its medical capabilities;
25	<u>or</u>

- 1 (c) Begin the transport within thirty minutes of the request; and
- 2 (3) The use of an air ambulance is precluded due to:
- 3 (a) Mechanical problems; or
- 4 (b) Inclement weather conditions.
