# Senate Bill 196

Introduced by: **Senator Zikmund**

1 **An Act to clarify provisions regarding historical license plates.**

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 **Section 1. That § 32-5-77 be AMENDED:**

4 **32-5-77.** Any person who is a resident of this state and the owner of a  
 5 noncommercial automobile, pickup truck, van, or truck, with a weight less than eight  
 6 thousand pounds, or a retired firetruck ~~which that~~ is more than at least thirty years old at  
 7 the time of applying for registration of the vehicle, may apply directly to the secretary for  
 8 historical license plates in lieu of the application provided for in §§ 32-5-2 and 32-5-3.  
 9 The historical license plates ~~shall~~ must be issued to the applicant instead of the usual  
 10 license plates after payment of a ~~ten-dollar~~ ten-dollar registration fee. Historical license  
 11 plates for a motor vehicle other than a motorcycle ~~shall~~ must be issued in pairs. A single  
 12 historical license plate ~~shall~~ must be issued for a motorcycle. ~~The license plates shall be~~  
 13 Each historical license plate is permanent for the life of the motor vehicle. No motor vehicle  
 14 ~~for which that is issued~~ historical license plates ~~have been issued~~ may be used for daily  
 15 transportation to and from a place of work or for commercial transportation. The motor  
 16 vehicle may be used for pleasure transportation, public displays, parades, and other  
 17 related pleasure or hobby activities, and may be driven to and from any facility providing  
 18 motor vehicle maintenance or repair. However, no motor vehicle ~~for which that~~ historical  
 19 plates have been issued on may be driven more than four thousand miles per year. Fees  
 20 collected under the provisions of this section ~~shall~~ must be credited to the state motor  
 21 vehicle fund.
