- SB 44 make an appropriation to reimburse health care professionals who have complied with the requirements for health care recruitment assistance programs, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- SB 58 revise provisions regarding money transmission.
(Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- SB 77 revise a provision related to threatening law enforcement officers.
(Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 85 (Removed from Consent Calendar) revise a provision related to an action to quiet title to real property. (Introduced)
- SB 108 (Removed from Consent Calendar) revise a provision related to retrocession of jurisdiction over federal enclaves. (Introduced)
- SB 111 revise requirements for mining and mineral exploration.
(Senate Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)

SB 167 limit annual valuation increases on owner-occupied single-family dwellings.

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1017 adopt the psychology interjurisdictional licensure compact. (Introduced)

HB 1034 (Deferred from 15th LD) require hydrogen pipelines to be permitted by the
Public Utilities Commission. (Introduced)

HB 1043 include lithium in the definition of precious metal for purposes of the minerals
severance tax, and to set the tax rate for lithium severed in this state.
(Senate Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)

HB 1046 (Removed from Consent Calendar) prohibit the intentional disarming of a law
enforcement officer and to provide a penalty therefor. (Introduced)

HB 1047 (Removed from Consent Calendar) enhance the penalties for eluding law
enforcement. (Introduced)

HB 1090 revise provisions related to tax deeds and to declare an emergency.
(Introduced)
