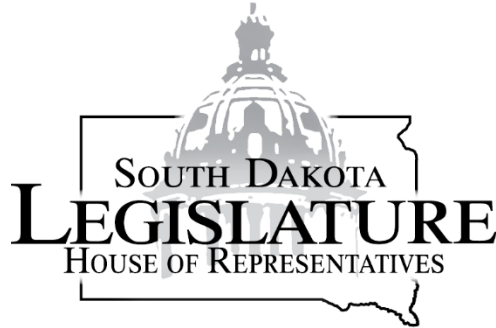

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1119 create a habitat conservation specialty plate and emblem. (House Transportation Engrossed)
HB 1120 provide special motor vehicle license plates for advanced life support personnel and emergency medical technicians. (House Transportation Engrossed)
HB 1130 revise water development district boundaries and taxing authority. (House Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)
HB 1132 revise certain provisions pertaining to municipal government. (House Local Government Engrossed)
HB 1062 make an appropriation for costs related to the suppression of wildfires impacting the state and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
