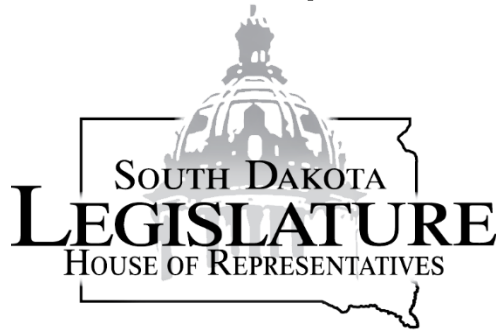

HB 1187, HB 1192, HB 1195, HB 1200

### SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- HB 1194 clarify provisions pertaining to tax increment finance districts.  
(House Local Government Engrossed)
- HB 1161 regulate the acceptance of a central bank digital currency. (Introduced)
- SB 88 provide information to an injured employee about eligibility in a program  
offered by a nonprofit organization. (Introduced)
- SB 79 revise provisions related to the possession, distribution, and manufacture of  
child pornography. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)

### SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1099 establish educational standards for the expanded practice of optometry.  
(Introduced)
- HB 1163 amend provisions of the Uniform Commercial Code. (Introduced)

### SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 17 (Deferred from 15<sup>th</sup> LD) modify the residency requirements for voter  
registration and declare an emergency. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 44 make an appropriation to reimburse health care professionals who have  
complied with the requirements for health care recruitment assistance  
programs, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- SB 78 provide for an E15 fuel tax refund.  
(House Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)
- SB 57 create uniform procedures for consideration of criminal histories and  
convictions in professional or occupational licensure. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 12 authorize certain employer actions regarding the use of cannabis by an  
employee or a prospective employee. (Introduced)
