AMENDMENT 1138A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

1 An Act to establish a sales tax exemption for certain disabled veterans.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 10-45:

4 There are exempted from the provisions of this chapter and from the tax imposed

5 on it, the gross receipts from sales of tangible personal property, any product transferred

6 <u>electronically, and services to a veteran who is rated as permanently and totally disabled</u>

7 from a service-connected <u>disability</u>. The amount of gross receipts exempt under this

8 <u>chapter in any year for any veteran may not exceed twenty five five thousand dollars.</u>

9 Section 2. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 10-45:

- 10To receive a veteran sales tax exemption card, a veteran who is rated as11permanently and totally disabled from a service-connected disability may submit an12application to the secretary of revenue containing all documentation required to determine13the eligibility of the applicant.
- 14The secretary of revenue, after verifying the eligibility of the applicant, shall issue15a veteran sales tax exemption card to the applicant. A person owning a veteran sales tax16exemption card may present the card to a retailer at the time of a sale to receive the sales17tax exemption provided in section 1 of this Act.18The secretary shall promulgate rules pursuant to chapter 1-26 to adopt forms for
- 19 a veteran sales tax exemption card.
