### MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- SB 35 (Concur in House Amendment) provide that certain personal information of a lottery prize winner may only be used for advertising or promotion with the winner's consent. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 177 (Intent to Reconsider Vote by Which Lost) permit the appointment of a circuit court judge or Supreme Court justice as a member of the Public Utilities Commission in place of a disqualified or incapacitated commissioner. (Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- SCR 605 (Deferred from 16<sup>th</sup> LD) Affirming the value of grassland ecosystems and the importance of farmers and ranchers as managers. (Introduced)

### SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 172 allow a person to temporarily take responsibility of a feral cat or dog for the purpose of spaying or neutering the animal. (Senate Local Government Engrossed)
- HB 1077 provide for the disbursement of catastrophic county poor relief fund to the participating counties in the event of the discontinuance of the fund. (Introduced)
- HB 1124 provide for the temporary filling of water development district board positions created as a result of population increases. (Introduced)
- HCR 6003 To create the One Hundredth Session Planning Committee of the South Dakota Legislature. (House State Affairs Engrossed)

### SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 152 (Removed from Consent Calendar) establish maximum fees for legal publications and to remove related rule-making authority from the Bureau of Administration. (Introduced)

### LEGISLATIVE COMMEMORATIONS

- HC 8012 Honoring the victims of Agent Orange during the Vietnam War.
