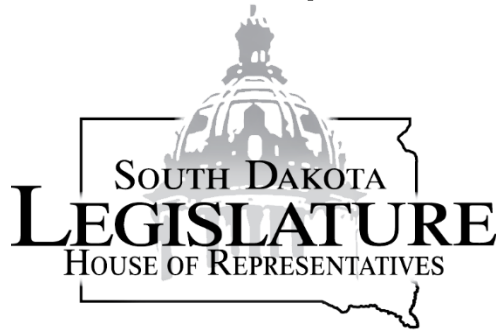

### CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF COMMITTEES (AMENDED BILLS)

HB 1185, HB 1186, HB 1164, HB 1208, HB 1212

### SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- HB 1100      modify certain requirements for eligibility to receive a gift of a museum collection from a county or municipality. (Introduced)
- SB 14        expand authorization for the conditional taking of coyotes from snowmobiles. (Senate Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)

### SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1198      (Deferred from 19<sup>th</sup> LD) (JR 5-17 with pending amendment) revise the process for nominating candidates for the offices of lieutenant governor, attorney general, and secretary of state. (Introduced)
- HB 1182      revise provisions pertaining to the observation of the conduct of an election. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1203      clarify references to the court in a condemnation proceeding. (Introduced)
- HB 1225      define a multi-passenger bicycle and to provide for the regulation of multi-passenger bicycles. (Introduced)
- HB 1057      create the Commission on Indigent Legal Services and Office of Indigent Legal Services. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1129      repeal the session law authorizing the Board of Regents to contract for the design and construction of a new dairy research and extension farm on the campus of South Dakota State University, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1156      make an appropriation to enhance the economic health of South Dakota. (Introduced)
- HB 1157      make an appropriation for the economic development of South Dakota. (Introduced)
