### SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

SB 212 allow for the payment of goods or services by a school district between school board meetings in certain circumstances. (Introduced)  
HB 1082 change the eligibility requirements, and the exempt value, of a property tax relief program for disabled veterans and surviving spouses. (Senate Taxation Engrossed)

### SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

SB 13 revise the process for nominating candidates for the offices of lieutenant governor, attorney general, and secretary of state. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)  
SB 130 (Deferred from 25<sup>th</sup> LD) consider certain goods when given as a prize through a redemption store as purchases for resale. (Introduced)  
SB 191 restrict the use of medical cannabis for individuals on probation or conditional release. (Senate Health and Human Services Engrossed)  
SB 195 modify provisions regarding the process to vacate certain highways. (Senate Local Government Engrossed)  
SB 198 (Removed from Consent Calendar) authorize school districts and nonpublic schools to acquire and administer nasal glucagon. (Introduced)  
SB 199 revise provisions pertaining to the consolidation or boundary changes of counties. (Senate Local Government Engrossed)  
SB 214 (Deferred from 25<sup>th</sup> LD) provide a rebuttable presumption in favor of joint physical custody of a minor child. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1023 provide immunity from liability for certain actions of the State Bar and its agents. (House Judiciary Engrossed)
- HB 1104 enhance the penalty for accessory to first- or second-degree murder. (Introduced)
- HB 1129 repeal the session law authorizing the Board of Regents to contract for the design and construction of a new dairy research and extension farm on the campus of South Dakota State University, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1163 (Removed from Consent Calendar) amend provisions of the Uniform Commercial Code. (Introduced)
