SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS HB 1023 provide immunity from liability for certain actions of the State Bar and its agents. (House Judiciary Engrossed) HB 1104 enhance the penalty for accessory to first- or second-degree murder. (Introduced) HB 1129 repeal the session law authorizing the Board of Regents to contract for the design and construction of a new dairy research and extension farm on the campus of South Dakota State University, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced) HB 1163 (Removed from Consent Calendar) amend provisions of the Uniform Commercial Code. (Introduced)
