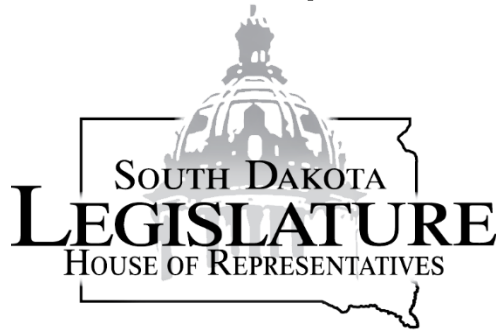

MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

HB 1255 (Intent to Reconsider Vote by Which Lost) establish a property tax exemption for religious societies, and to modify the application requirements for certain property tax exemptions. (House Taxation Engrossed)

CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF COMMITTEES (AMENDED BILLS)

HB 1118

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

SB 169 revise provisions regarding drones. (Senate Transportation Engrossed)

SB 188 modify the time before which rural access infrastructure grant moneys must be expended or obligated. (Senate Engrossed)

SB 194 create a license plate for certain retired firefighters and clarify provisions regarding special firefighter license plates. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1039 provide for the payment of legal expenses originating from crime committed at a facility maintained by the Department of Corrections.
(House Appropriations Engrossed)

HB 1060 revise certain provisions related to travel reimbursement.
(House Appropriations Engrossed)

HB 1118 revise unclaimed property provisions. (House Appropriations Engrossed)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

SB 112 (Deferred from 26th LD) establish a non-resident title fee. (Introduced)

SB 152 (Deferred from 26th LD) establish maximum fees for legal publications and to remove related rule-making authority from the Bureau of Administration.
(Introduced)

SB 172 (Deferred from 26th LD) allow a person to temporarily take responsibility of a feral cat or dog for the purpose of spaying or neutering the animal.
(Senate Local Government Engrossed)

Individuals needing assistance, pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act, should contact the Legislative Research Council (605-773-3251) 48 hours before convening to make any necessary arrangements.

- SB 42 (Deferred from 26th LD) modify provisions related to medical cannabis.
(Senate Health and Human Services Engrossed)
- SB 10 require that a notification of medical cannabis certification be provided to a patient's primary or referring practitioner.
(House Health and Human Services Engrossed)
- SB 43 establish procedures for the imposition of fines and probation against medical cannabis establishments, increase the allowable fee for a medical cannabis establishment registration certificate, and direct the Department of Health to promulgate rules to increase the fee for a registration certificate.
(House Health and Human Services Engrossed)
