## **Senate Bill 80**

## AMENDMENT 80A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

1	An Act to improve technology equipment for providers of elderly care and to make
2	an appropriation therefor.

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$5,000,000
- 5 \$3,000,000 to the Department of Human Services, for providing grants to select providers for
- 6 the purchase of technology equipment that would improve the quality of life and health
- 7 <u>outcomes of elderly residents and support health care workers.</u>
- 8 **Section 2.** A select provider must be a state-licensed Medicaid provider that primarily serves
- 9 elderly patients. A select provider shall fill out an application detailing what technology
- 10 equipment will be used, the expected outcomes in terms of the quality of life and health
- outcomes for the provider's residents and support for the provider's health care workers to
- 12 fulfill the worker's duties, and any other information necessary for the department to evaluate
- 13 an application.
- 14 **Section 3.** Before any moneys are expended under this Act, the Department of Human
- 15 Services shall evaluate each application based on the criteria on the application submitted in
- 16 section 2 of this Act. The moneys appropriated in this Act must be expended for the technology
- 17 equipment described in the approved application.
- 18 **Section 4.** The department shall provide a report to the Joint Committee on Appropriations
- 19 detailing how the grants were used. The report shall include providers awarded a grant using
- the moneys in this Act, amount of money awarded to each provider, technology equipment
- 21 purchased, the use of the technology equipment, and the number of patients served through
- 22 the grant.
- 23 **Section 5.** The secretary of the Department of Human Services shall approve vouchers and
- the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

- 1 **Section 6.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- 2 <u>revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.</u>
- 3 **Section 7.** This Act is effective beginning June 29, 2024.
