HB 1057	create the Commission on Indigent Legal Services and Office of Indigent Legal Services. (House Engrossed)
HB 1096	provide that a temporary restraining order may extend beyond thirty days in certain circumstances involving stalking. (Introduced)
HB 1183	modernize the process for annual audits of third-party insurance administrators. (Introduced)
HB 1187	create a one-year career and technical education instructor educator permit. (House Education Engrossed)
HB 1197	require the publication of measures taken to restrict the access of obscene materials by minors. (Introduced)
HB 1228	provide that required exterior hunting garments may be fluorescent pink.
