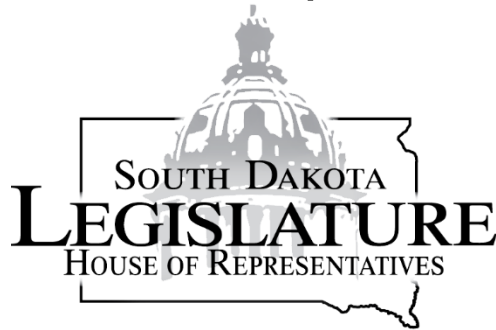

MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1038 (Consideration of Senate amendments) exclude certain habitual DUI offenders from eligibility for presumptive probation. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- HB 1076 (Consideration of Senate amendments) require the consideration of the definition of antisemitism when investigating unfair or discriminatory practices. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- HB 1089 (Consideration of Senate amendments) exclude certain crimes from presumptive probation. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)

- SB 111 revise requirements for mining and mineral exploration. (Senate Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)
