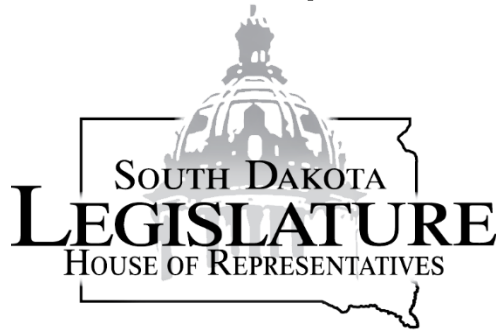

### CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF COMMITTEES (AMENDED BILLS)

HB 1022, HB 1061, HB 1065, HB 1093

### SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 64      revise provisions related to the regulation of emergency medical services and associated personnel. (House Health and Human Services Engrossed)
- SB 182     repeal and revise certain provisions regarding the petition circulation process to comply with federal court decisions. (Introduced)
- SB 148     provide permissive authority to a governing body of a municipality or county to deny reissuance of an on-sale license not actively used. (Introduced)
- SB 61      repeal the Visitation Grant Advisory Group. (Introduced)
- SB 175     add a domestic abuse shelter to the definition of a community safety zone. (Introduced)

### SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1201    make an appropriation for the teacher apprenticeship pathway program. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1022    make an appropriation to the Department of Education to provide professional development in literacy to teachers, and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1061    make an appropriation for costs related to emergencies and disasters impacting the state and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1065    make an appropriation for the design and construction of a multi-use building on the grounds of the State Fair and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1093    make an appropriation to provide a grant for the construction of a facility to provide certain health facilities and services. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1064    make an appropriation for increases in the construction costs of infrastructure at Lake Alvin and Newell Lake, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)

## SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 43 (Deferred from 28<sup>th</sup> LD) establish procedures for the imposition of fines and probation against medical cannabis establishments, increase the allowable fee for a medical cannabis establishment registration certificate, and direct the Department of Health to promulgate rules to increase the fee for a registration certificate. (House Health and Human Services Engrossed)
- SB 117 (Deferred from 29<sup>th</sup> LD) revise provisions regarding industrial hemp. (Introduced)
- SB 98 (Deferred from 29<sup>th</sup> LD) (Removed from Consent Calendar) establish the admissibility of evidence of similar crimes in child molestation cases. (Introduced)
- SB 58 (Deferred from 29<sup>th</sup> LD) revise provisions regarding money transmission. (House Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- SB 50 make an appropriation for the site preparation and construction of a prison facility for offenders committed to the Department of Corrections in Rapid City, to transfer moneys to the incarceration construction fund, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- SB 18 allow the secretary of state to share information from the statewide voter registration file. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 115 prevent a county, township, or municipality from authorizing a guaranteed income program. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 89 reduce the notice requirement period to terminate a tenancy at will. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 90 revise and repeal provisions related to forcible entry and detainer. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 6 revise provisions related to death by distribution of a Schedule I or II substance. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 211 revise notarial acts. (Introduced)
