- SB 45 make an appropriation for the establishment of a Center for Quantum Information Science and Technology and to declare an emergency.

- SB 49 make an appropriation for the site preparation of a prison facility for offenders committed to the Department of Corrections, to transfer moneys to the incarceration construction fund, and to declare an emergency.
(Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 53 make an appropriation for eligible water and wastewater projects and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 80 improve technology equipment for providers of elderly care and to make an appropriation therefor. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 83 make an appropriation to support firefighter training efforts in the state.
(Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 125 require the Department of Social Services to conduct a state-wide study on child care, to provide an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.

- HB 1225 (Removed from Consent Calendar) define a multi-passenger bicycle and to provide for the regulation of multi-passenger bicycles. (House Engrossed)
- HB 1060 revise certain provisions related to travel reimbursement. (House Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1118 revise unclaimed property provisions. (House Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1211 repeal the Midwestern Regional Higher Education Compact. (Introduced)
