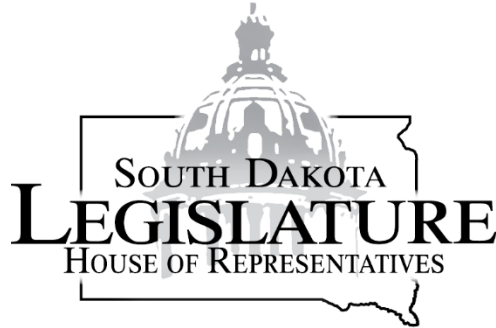

MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1130 (Consideration of Senate amendments) revise water development district boundaries. (Senate Local Government Engrossed)
- HB 1178 (Consideration of Senate amendments) prohibit the Board of Regents or any institution under its control from using state resources for obscene live conduct. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1225 (Consideration of Senate amendments) define a multi-passenger quadricycle and to provide for the regulation of multi-passenger quadricycles. (Senate Engrossed)

CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF COMMITTEES (AMENDED BILLS)

SB 123, SB 146

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 151 revise and repeal provisions related to the licensure of athletic trainers. (House Health and Human Services Engrossed)
- SB 212 allow for the payment of goods or services by a school district between school board meetings in certain circumstances. (Introduced)
- SB 191 restrict the use of medical cannabis for individuals on probation or conditional release. (Senate Health and Human Services Engrossed)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 49 make an appropriation for the site preparation of a prison facility for offenders committed to the Department of Corrections, to transfer moneys to the incarceration construction fund, and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 127 improve education in South Dakota. (Introduced)
- SB 47 (Removed from Consent Calendar) revise the incentive program for juvenile diversion opportunities. (Introduced)
- SB 198 (Removed from Consent Calendar) authorize school districts and nonpublic schools to acquire and administer nasal glucagon. (Introduced)

- SB 1 (Removed from Consent Calendar) expand eligibility for the reduced tuition benefit for certain school district and Head Start employees at Board of Regents institutions to school counselors. (Introduced)
- SB 45 make an appropriation for the establishment of a Center for Quantum Information Science and Technology and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 53 make an appropriation for eligible water and wastewater projects and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 83 make an appropriation for the revised construction costs of maintenance shops for the Wildland Fire Suppression Division and to declare an emergency. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 168 make an appropriation for victim services. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 187 make an appropriation to establish a cybersecurity services initiative for counties and municipalities and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 209 make an appropriation for grants to assisted living centers and nursing facilities for costs related to telemedicine. (Introduced)
- SB 80 improve technology equipment for providers of elderly care and to make an appropriation therefor. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 134 make an appropriation to create the healthy forest critical infrastructure relief and grant program and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 144 make an appropriation for grants to support airport terminal improvement, expansion, and infrastructure projects. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 73 provide that the presiding officer of the Senate is required to sign each enrolled bill. (Introduced)
- SB 177 permit the appointment of a circuit court judge or Supreme Court justice as a member of the Public Utilities Commission in place of a disqualified or incapacitated commissioner. (Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- SB 165 create the South Dakota-Ireland Trade Commission. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 217 require disclosure of certain information prior to the sale of property bound by a homeowners' association. (Introduced)
