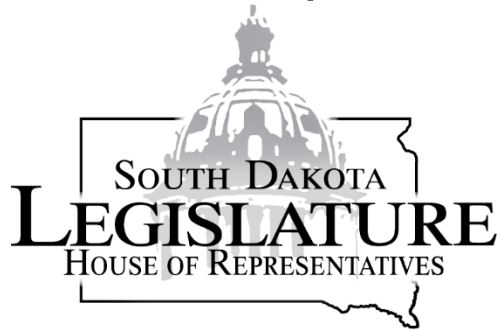

MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1057 (Consideration of Senate amendments) create the Commission on Indigent Legal Services and Office of Indigent Legal Services, to make an appropriation for reimbursing county indigent legal services, and to declare an emergency. (Senate Engrossed)
- HB 1092 (Consideration of Senate amendments) revise provisions regarding the 911 emergency surcharge. (Senate Engrossed) (Fiscal Note)

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 124 revise the eligibility of roads for the rural access infrastructure fund. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 45 (Deferred from 33rd LD) make an appropriation for the establishment of a Center for Quantum Information Science and Technology and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 53 (Deferred from 33rd LD) make an appropriation for eligible water and wastewater projects and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 73 (Deferred from 33rd LD) provide that the presiding officer of the Senate is required to sign each enrolled bill. (Introduced)
- SB 168 (Deferred from 33rd LD) make an appropriation for victim services. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 83 (Deferred from 33rd LD) make an appropriation for the revised construction costs of maintenance shops for the Wildland Fire Suppression Division and to declare an emergency. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 177 (Deferred from 33rd LD) permit the appointment of a circuit court judge or Supreme Court justice as a member of the Public Utilities Commission in place of a disqualified or incapacitated commissioner. (Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)

- SB 80 (Deferred from 33rd LD) improve technology equipment for providers of elderly care and to make an appropriation therefor. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 209 (Deferred from 33rd LD) make an appropriation for grants to assisted living centers and nursing facilities for costs related to telemedicine. (Introduced)
- SB 217 (Deferred from 33rd LD) require disclosure of certain information prior to the sale of property bound by a homeowners' association. (Introduced)
- SB 187 (Deferred from 33rd LD) make an appropriation to establish a cybersecurity services initiative for counties and municipalities and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 165 (Deferred from 33rd LD) create the South Dakota-Ireland Trade Commission. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 134 (Deferred from 33rd LD) make an appropriation to create the healthy forest critical infrastructure relief and grant program and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 144 (Deferred from 33rd LD) make an appropriation for grants to support airport terminal improvement, expansion, and infrastructure projects. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 182 (Deferred from 31st LD) (Removed from Consent Calendar) repeal and revise certain provisions regarding the petition circulation process to comply with federal court decisions. (Introduced)
- SB 137 (Deferred from 32nd LD) make an appropriation for the health and wellbeing of South Dakotans. (Introduced)
- SB 138 (Deferred from 32nd LD) make an appropriation to provide for the development of South Dakota. (Introduced)
- SB 191 (Removed from Consent Calendar) restrict the use of medical cannabis for individuals on probation or conditional release. (Senate Health and Human Services Engrossed)
- SB 123 revise provisions pertaining to voter registration requirements and the state board of elections. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 146 revise and repeal provisions related to threatening elected officers and to provide a penalty therefor. (House Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 128 improve public safety in South Dakota. (Introduced)
- SB 129 improve the workforce of South Dakota. (Introduced)
