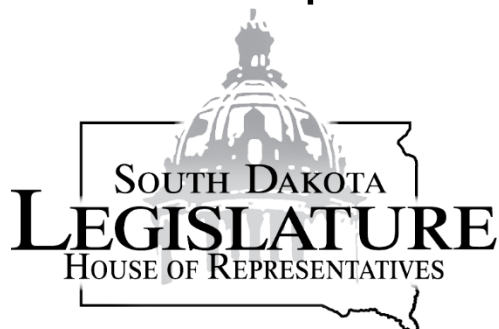

House Page Resolution 4

HB 1157 (Consideration of Senate amendments) make an appropriation for the economic development of South Dakota. (Senate Engrossed)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1259 appropriate money for the ordinary expenses of the legislative, judicial, and executive departments of the state, the current expenses of state institutions, interest on the public debt, and for common schools. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

SB 51 revise property tax levies for school districts and to revise the state aid to general and special education formulas. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)

SB 52 revise the General Appropriations Act for fiscal year 2024. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed) (Fiscal Note)
