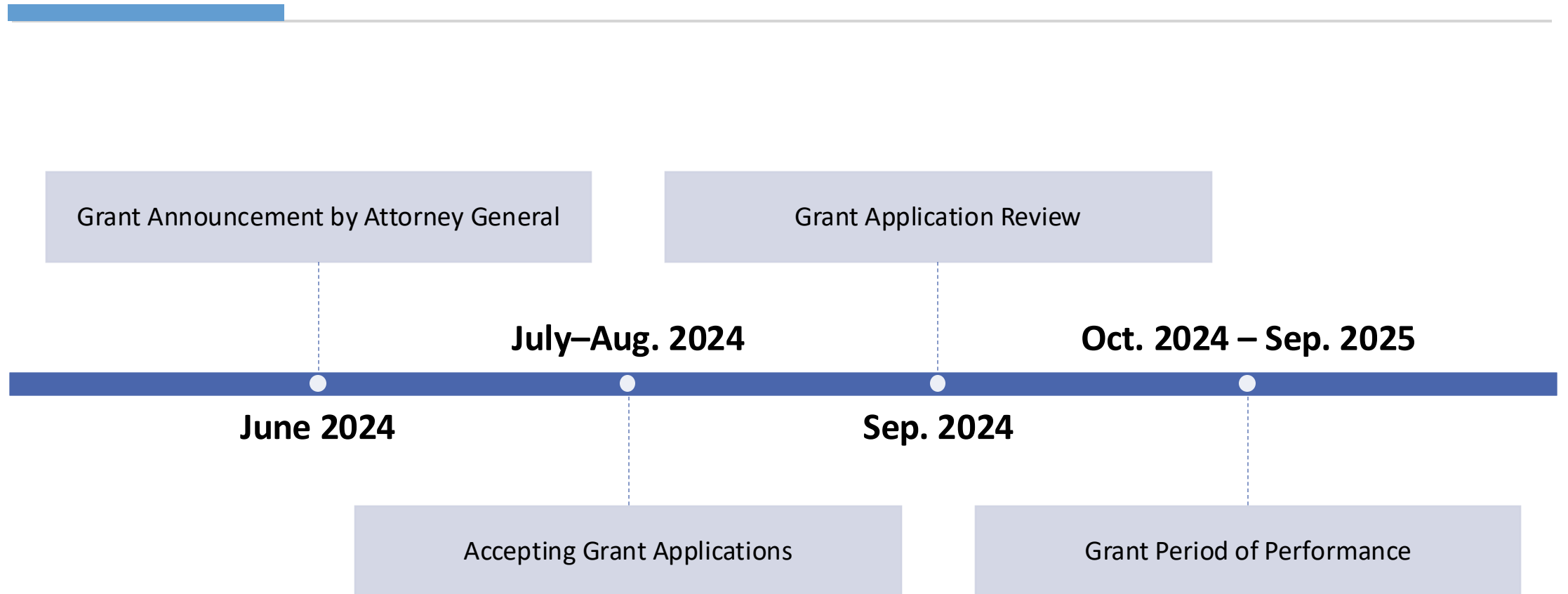
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# Victim Services Grant Program Update

- SB 168 of 2024 Legislative Session appropriated \$5 million one-time to the Office of Attorney General to provide grants to organizations that assist:
    - children who have been abused or neglected,
    - victims of domestic violence, and
    - victims of sexual assault

  - how the budget aligns to the need and goals

# Grant Awards

- Awards will be made to successful applicants for a project period of October 1, 2024 to September 30, 2025
- Grant funds will be paid to recipients on a reimbursement basis
