



## 2025 South Dakota Legislature

# Senate Bill 33

*Introduced by: The Chair of the Senate Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources*

1 **An Act to make appropriations for water and environmental purposes and to declare**  
 2 **an emergency.**

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the South Dakota water and  
 5 environment fund the sum of \$1,000,000, in other fund expenditure authority, to the  
 6 Board of Water and Natural Resources, for the purpose of providing a grant to local project  
 7 sponsors for a feasibility-level study, system startup, and administration of the Dakota  
 8 Mainstem regional water system study.

9 Moneys must be provided according to terms and conditions established by the  
 10 Board of Water and Natural Resources.

11 **Section 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the South Dakota water and  
 12 environment fund the sum of \$2,000,000, in other fund expenditure authority, to the  
 13 Board of Water and Natural Resources, for the purpose of providing a grant to local project  
 14 sponsors for the engineering design, preconstruction activities, and construction of the  
 15 facilities included in the Water Investment in Northern South Dakota project.

16 Moneys must be provided according to terms and conditions established by the  
 17 Board of Water and Natural Resources.

18 **Section 3.** There is hereby appropriated from the South Dakota water and  
 19 environment fund the sum of \$12,000,000, in other fund expenditure authority, to the  
 20 Board of Water and Natural Resources, for the purpose of providing grants and loans to  
 21 project sponsors under the state consolidated water facilities construction program,  
 22 established pursuant to § 46A-1-63.1.

23 Moneys must be provided according to terms and conditions established by the  
 24 Board of Water and Natural Resources.

25 **Section 4.** There is hereby appropriated from the South Dakota water and  
 26 environment fund the sum of \$2,500,000, in other fund expenditure authority, to the

1 Board of Water and Natural Resources, for the purpose of providing grants and loans to  
2 project sponsors under the state solid waste management program established pursuant  
3 to § 46A-1-83.

4 The Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources may use up to \$250,000 of  
5 the funds appropriated by this section, to contract for the statewide cleanup of waste tires  
6 and solid waste. Notwithstanding § 46A-1-61, the department may fund up to one hundred  
7 percent of the nonfederal share of statewide waste tires and solid waste cleanup projects.

8 Moneys must be provided according to terms and conditions established by the  
9 Board of Water and Natural Resources.

10 **Section 5.** There is hereby appropriated, from administrative expense surcharge  
11 fees deposited in the state water pollution control revolving fund program subfund, the  
12 sum of \$200,000, in other fund expenditure authority, to the Board of Water and Natural  
13 Resources, for the purpose of providing water quality grants under the state water  
14 pollution control revolving fund program, established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1.

15 Moneys must be provided according to terms and conditions established by the  
16 Board of Water and Natural Resources.

17 **Section 6.** There is hereby appropriated, from administrative expense surcharge  
18 fees deposited in the state water pollution control revolving fund program subfund, the  
19 sum of \$300,000, in other fund expenditure authority, to the Board of Water and Natural  
20 Resources, for the purpose of contracting for the preparation of applications and the  
21 administration of clean water state revolving fund loans under the state water pollution  
22 control revolving fund program, established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1.

23 Moneys must be provided according to terms and conditions established by the  
24 Board of Water and Natural Resources.

25 **Section 7.** There is hereby appropriated, from administrative expense surcharge  
26 fees deposited in the state drinking water revolving fund program subfund, the sum of  
27 \$300,000, in other fund expenditure authority, to the Board of Water and Natural  
28 Resources, for the purpose of contracting for the preparation of applications and the  
29 administration of drinking water state revolving fund loans under the state drinking water  
30 revolving fund program, established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1.

31 Moneys must be provided according to terms and conditions established by the  
32 Board of Water and Natural Resources.

33 **Section 8.** There is hereby appropriated, for federal moneys deposited in the state  
34 drinking water revolving fund program subfund, the sum of \$300,000, in federal fund  
35 expenditure authority, to the Board of Water and Natural Resources, for the purpose of

1 providing small system technical assistance and local assistance set-aside grants, or  
2 contracts, to eligible entities under the state drinking water revolving fund program,  
3 established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1.

4 Moneys must be provided according to terms and conditions established by the  
5 Board of Water and Natural Resources.

6 **Section 9.** There is hereby appropriated for federal moneys deposited in the state  
7 water pollution control revolving fund program subfund, the sum of \$100,000, in federal  
8 fund expenditure authority, to the Board of Water and Natural Resources, for the purpose  
9 of providing small system technical assistance set-aside grants, or contracts, to eligible  
10 entities under the state water pollution control revolving fund program, established  
11 pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1.

12 Moneys must be provided according to terms and conditions established by the  
13 Board of Water and Natural Resources.

14 **Section 10.** There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$30,000,000, in federal fund  
15 expenditure authority, to the Board of Water and Natural Resources, for the purpose of  
16 providing grants to eligible entities for projects to address emerging contaminants in  
17 drinking water under the federal emerging contaminants in small or disadvantaged  
18 communities grant program.

19 Moneys must be provided according to terms and conditions established by the  
20 Board of Water and Natural Resources.

21 **Section 11.** The secretary of the Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources  
22 shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures  
23 authorized by this Act.

24 **Section 12.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or  
25 obligated shall revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.

26 **Section 13.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government  
27 and its existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act  
28 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
