## House Bill 1048

Introduced by: Representative Sjaarda

- 1 An Act to require that cash be accepted for certain transactions.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 37-24:
- Except as provided in section 2 of this Act, a person must accept cash as a form of payment for any goods or services sold to a consumer if:
- 6 (1) The sale and payment for the goods or services occurs in person;
- 7 (2) The person selling the goods or services, or an individual employed by the person selling the goods or services, is physically present at the time of the sale to accept a cash payment; and
- 10 (3) The purchaser of the goods or services chooses to pay the purchase price using 11 cash.
- For purposes of this section, "cash" means physical coin, currency, or note that is designed as legal tender by federal law.

## 14 Section 2. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 37-24:

- 15 The provisions of section 1 of this Act do not apply to:
- 16 (1) Financial institutions, as defined in § 10-43-1;
- 17 (2) The sale of goods or services that require a credit card for purposes of placing a 18 security deposit or covering unforeseen damages or expenses; or
- 19 (3) The sale of, or payment for, goods or services occurring on an airplane.

## Section 3. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 37-24:

- 21 The state and its political subdivisions must accept cash as a form of payment for 22 any fee or charge imposed on any member of the public if;
- 23 (1) The payment is submitted in person; and

24 (2) The member of the public chooses to submit payment in the form of cash.
