## What is the South Dakota Municipal League (SDML)?

- The SDML is a nonprofit, nonpartisan organization.
- Founded in 1934, it represents the interests of cities and towns across South Dakota.
- Serves as an educational resource, advocate, and voice for local governments.
- Includes 309 incorporated municipalities in South Dakota.

## Key Functions of SDML

#### 1. Legislative Advocacy

- Acts as lobbyist for municipalities during legislative session
- Testify on bills, draft proposed legislation, and build and participate in coalitions
- Maintain close relationships with state lawmakers and state agencies

#### 2. Educational Resource

- Provide training for local government officials, including elected leaders, city managers, finance officers and other staff
- Host conferences, workshops, and seminars on municipal governance and best practices

#### The SDML's Mission

To provide services that strengthen and advance the capacity of local governments in South Dakota.

## Key Goals

- 1. Connect members, partners and ideas to foster growth and innovation
- 2. Educate members to develop effective public servants and leadership skills
- 3. Advocate for the people of our cities with a strong, collective voice

## SDML Collaboration with State Agencies

- Work frequently with Department of Revenue, Department of Legislative Audit, Department of Transportation, Attorney General's Office, Department of Public Safety to ensure effective policy implementation at the local level.
- Assist municipalities in preparing for and responding to state-level disasters be connecting them with the appropriate divisions at the Department of Emergency Management.
- Aid in finding and accessing state grant programs and funding.

## SDML Engagement Opportunities

#### 1. Legislative Rib Dinner & Local Government Day

An annual event where municipal leaders meet with state lawmakers to discuss priority issues – February 4 and February 5, 2025

#### 2. District Meetings

Post-session meetings in our ten districts where members can connect with legislators, as well as other local leaders and share ideas.

#### 3. Annual Conference

Provides educational sessions, networking opportunities, and updates on key state issues.

#### **Training Programs**


