AMENDMENT 1076A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

1An Act to modify provisions pertaining to improper collection of fees relating to2assistance or referrals in a veterans benefits matter.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 33A-2:

5 Except as permitted under federal law, a person may not receive any money, thing 6 of value, or financial benefit for preparing, presenting, prosecuting, advising, consulting, 7 or assisting any individual with regard to a veterans benefits matter before the United 8 States Department of Veterans Affairs, the United States Department of Defense, or the 9 South Dakota Department of Veterans Affairs. 10 A person may not receive any money, thing of value, or financial benefit for 11 referring any individual to another person to prepare, present, prosecute, advise, consult, 12 or assist regarding any veterans benefits matter before the United States Department of Veterans Affairs, the United States Department of Defense, or the South Dakota 13 14 Department of Veterans Affairs. 15 Nothing in this section may be construed to prohibit a division of fees between 16 attorneys, which is otherwise proper under the laws of this state and the South Dakota 17 Rules of Professional Conduct.

18 A violation of this section is a deceptive trade practice under chapter 37-24. 19 For the purposes of this-Act section, "veterans benefits matter" means any claim 20 affecting any person who has filed, or expressed an intent to file, a claim for any benefit, 21 program, service, commodity, function, or status, to which entitlement is determined 22 under the laws and regulations administered by the United States Department of Veterans 23 Affairs, the United States Department of Defense, or the South Dakota Department of 24 Veterans Affairs, and pertaining to a veteran, the dependent or survivor of a veteran, or 25 any other individual eligible for a benefit, program, service, commodity, function, or

1 Section 2. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 33A-2:

2 3 Any person who receives any money, thing of value, or financial benefit for 4 preparing, presenting, prosecuting, advising, consulting, or assisting any individual with 5 regard to a veterans benefits matter before the United States Department of Veterans 6 Affairs, the United States Department of Defense, or the South Dakota Department of 7 Veterans Affairs must be held to the same ethical standard as an attorney is held to in the 8 South Dakota Rules of Professional Conduct regarding the following areas: 9 (1) Advertising; 10 (2) Solicitation of new clients; 11 (3) Confidentiality; 12 (4) Duty of care; 13 (5) Duty of honesty; and 14 (6) Duty to zealously pursue <u>client</u>
