14	that is designated as legal tender by federal law.
15	For the purposes of this section, "qualifying school" means any school district,
16	department accredited accredited nonpublic school, and institution under the control of
17	the South Dakota Board of Regents or the South Dakota Board of Technical Education.
18	For the purpose of this section, "school-affiliated event" means:
19	(1) Any athletic competition, play, musical, concert, performance, or other activity that
