AMENDMENT 1082A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

_	All Act to revise juror qualifications permit a person seventy-live years or age or
2	older to request to be excused from jury duty.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
4	Section 1. That § 16-13-10 be AMENDED:
5	16-13-10. Any A_citizen of this state, who is a is eligible to serve as a juror if the
6	<u>citizen is:</u>
7	(1) A resident of the county or jury district where the jury is selected, eighteen;
8	(2) Eighteen years of age or older and under seventy years of age prior to January first
9	of the year of jury service, of:
10	(3) Of sound mind; and who is able
11	(4) Able to read, write, and understand the English language, is eligible to serve as a
12	juror.
13	Any member of the clergy, as defined in § 19-19-505, if jury service conflicts with
14	religious belief, is exempt from jury duty. Any member of a church or religious
15	organization is exempt from jury duty if jury service conflicts with the religious belief of
16	that church or religious organization. Any person who has been convicted of a felony,
17	unless restored to civil rights, is not eligible to serve as a juror. No potential juror may be
18	excluded from jury duty because of a visual or hearing impairment.

Section 1. That § 16-13-10.3 be AMENDED:

16-13-10.3. Any person-eighty seventy-five years of age or older may request to be excused from jury duty. The judge shall give substantial weight to the person's request to be relieved from jury duty, balancing the request with the need to impanel a jury.
