CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF COMMITTEES (AMENDED BILLS)

SB 88 (Consent Calendar)

SECOND READING AND CONSIDERATION OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 29 amend provisions regarding the Division of Insurance and the former Division of Securities operating fund. (Introduced)
- SB 47 clarify eligibility for licensure as a video lottery operator. (Introduced)
- SB 72 revise the payor of autopsy costs in certain circumstances.
(Senate Local Government Engrossed)
- SB 93 prohibit payment or rebate of insurance deductibles by contractors providing motor vehicle repair services. (Introduced)
- HB 1011 revise provisions related to the stenographic recording of certain proceedings. (Introduced)
- HB 1022 prohibit the misbranding of any cell-cultured protein product. (Introduced)
- HB 1049 update the official code of laws. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 60 (Deferred from 12th LD) expand the access and investigatory authority of the state auditor. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 67 establish the state office of apprenticeship within the Department of Labor and Regulation. (Introduced)
- SB 68 (Deferred from 12th LD) require an individual be a citizen of the United States before being eligible to vote and to provide a penalty therefor. (Introduced)
- SB 82 require an official declaration of war or other Congressional action before the South Dakota National Guard may be deployed by the federal government. (Introduced)
- SJR 503 Proposing and submitting to the voters at the next general election an amendment to the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, clarifying that an individual must be a citizen of the United States to be eligible to vote. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
