SB 39 revise the description of highways included in the state trunk highway system. (Introduced)
SB 41 clarify the minimum age requirements for a hunting license. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1079 increase the number of off-sale licenses from two to three in municipalities of one thousand or less. (House Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
HB 1015 increase licensure fees related to the practice of funeral service and cremation. (Introduced)

SB 2 increase civil penalties for commercial driver violations.
(Senate Transportation Engrossed)
SB 40 revise Department of Transportation regulatory authority regarding aeronautics. (Introduced)
SB 7 prohibit the adoption or implementation of certain policies related to immigration enforcement. (Introduced)
